ABSTRACT

The present aim was to find out the perceived social support on martial satisfaction among love and arranged marriage couples. Another purpose of this study was to find out the ratio of perceived social support on martial satisfaction among love and arranged marriage couples. The sample was comprised of (N=360) married couples. (N=180) love marriage couple (N=180) arranged marriage couples .data related to study was collected required sample on personal level from their home. The Multidimensional scale of perceived social support and Test Your Own Marriage Satisfaction Scale are used in this study. Result indicates that there is significant positive relationship between perceived social support and Marriage Satisfaction. Finding also indicates that perceived social support is significant predictor of martial satisfaction among love and arranged marriage couples. Finding also used for further study.
