THE ALBANIAN FAMILY CODE - A STEP FORWARD IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF FAMILY RELATIONS

ABSTRACT

The parents and the family are primary responsible for the protection and upbringing of the child. The Albanian legislation which regulates the relations between the child and the parents, the family or the other persons responsible for upbringing of the child, gives priority to the rights and responsibilities of parents, family and other legal guardians of the child.
