- creative activity of an innovative nature; it creates the conditions for evaluating creative activity based on the innovation of the results;

- regularly developing creative activity; it provides for the development of students' creative activity with the transition from class to class.
- creative activity aimed at solving problems; with the fulfillment of a number of tasks, it reflects situations that determine the creative activity of students and in this process their changing thinking will be reflected;
- creative activity aimed at improving existing facilities; in order to further improve existing facilities in their structure should be transformations with a creative approach.

Based on the aforementioned analysis of indicators of creative activity, identifying existing indicators in students is a complex pedagogical phenomenon. According to experts, the process of understanding creative activity begins with an understanding of creative actions. But mechanisms for identifying creative activity are not well developed.
