ACQUISITION ORDER OF GRAMMAR MORPHEMES (ON THE EXAMPLE OF RUSSIAN RESIDENTS WHO LIVING IN UZBEKISTAN)

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ABSTRACT

The process of mastering morphemes is one of the most interesting topics in applied linguistics and psycholinguistics. The article states that in order to test the hypothesis of natural order for the Uzbek language, an experiment was conducted with 50 Russian language learners studying Uzbek as a second language.
