That is why today's era requires the formation of strong family, which is ideologically protected, spiritually mature. In the Uzbek family, attention to education, morality and upbringing is one of our duties, which has long been ingrained in our blood. The proverb "Seven neighboring parents for one child" is also typical of our people. This proverb itself shows how important the education and upbringing of children, family life is for us. The residents of the neighborhood, especially the luminaries, never passed by a child who was behaving badly on the street, and at the same time reprimanded and corrected him. After all, in our sacred religion, which commands to be perfect in every way, to be polite, exemplary, and to purify the concupiscence, great importance is attached to the family. The family environment becomes stable as the parent feels responsibly. In addition to parents, the neighborhood should be a great role model for children to grow up politely. It is not in vain that our people say, "He does what he sees in the bird's nest." In the process of globalization, the role of the family in society, family upbringing, the relationship between parents and children, as well as the purity and strength of the family play an important role. Our great ancestor Amir Temur considered the peaceful life of the people, the inviolability of homes, the construction of a new family on the basis of integrity and cleanliness as a matter of national importance, and understood that a healthy generation is a key factor in the country's future. Therefore, during this period, science and culture developed at an unprecedented rate, world-renowned scientists, poets, historians and artists emerged in almost all fields, the country was able to put an end to war, conflict and cultural progress. In the period of ideological threat and danger, the issue of creating the necessary conditions for the formation of a healthy family and a high moral and ethical environment in the family, preparing young people for marriage, ensuring the strength and interests of families, bringing up healthy children has risen to the level of state policy. At the same time, special attention is paid to changing the thinking and consciousness of our young men and women who will marry in the future, first of all, on the sanctity of the family and the responsibility of marriage. The range of measures aimed at forming in the minds of our daughters the responsibility of motherhood and fatherhood in our

sons, preparing them for this, radically improving the legal literacy of young families and protecting the rights and legitimate interests of the child in the family is expanding. The Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Law "On Guarantees of the Rights of the Child", the Law "On Guardianship and Sponsorship", the Law "On Prevention of Juvenile Delinquency and Offenses" and the Code of Family and Administrative Liability guarantee full protection of the interests of our children and minors. In particular, Article 64 of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan stipulates that parents are obliged to support and raise their children until they reach adulthood, while the Code of Family and Administrative Liability states that parents have equal rights and obligations towards their children. If the child is fully capable of treatment, the parents are not liable for his or her obligations, in particular the obligations arising from the damage he or she has caused. That parents have the right and obligation to raise their children. Parents are responsible for the upbringing and development of their children. They must take care of the health, physical, mental, spiritual and moral maturity of their children. Parents have a superior right over all other persons in the upbringing of their children. The condition that parents ensure that their children receive the necessary level of education established by law. Failure by parents or guardians to fulfill their obligations to raise and educate minors may result in a fine. The protection of the rights and interests of children is the responsibility of their parents. Parents are the legal representatives of their children and in their relations with any natural or legal person, they are shown to protect their rights and interests without special authority in court. The family is the basis, status and foundation of upbringing. Who the child will be in the future depends on the family environment - the educational impact, and the effectiveness of family upbringing directly depends on the reputation and personal example of the parents in the family. Parents should set an example for their children by their good behavior. At the same time, it encourages the child to acquire knowledge, to act with a purpose in mind, not indifferent to their future. The ultimate goal of family upbringing is to raise a perfect person from a child. Implementing this includes physical education, mental education (religious), mental and intellectual education, moral education (aesthetic and sexual), will education, speech education, labor education and others. Physical education includes raising a child to be physically strong, teaching them cleanliness and hygiene (in modern parlance - sanitation and hygiene), adapting them to sports and physical education. Parents who want their child to be healthy should spend more time outdoors with them, mobilizing them for activities such as swimming, riding, wrestling games, and sniping. The task of spiritual upbringing is to form the child's goals, beliefs, religion, faith, to develop his true human qualities; in emotionally sensitive and impressionable children, the ability to see the truth, the formation of qualities such as courage, perseverance, and, conversely, the upbringing of hard-hearted children with the help of factors that soften their hearts. Such upbringing is important in protecting the child from depression and frustration in the face of difficulties.

In order to improve the development of the mind and thinking, classes are held to help improve the child's thinking, intelligence, memory and observation skills, he is told various exemplary tales and stories, memorized the necessary knowledge and information. Usually, children will ask questions about everything they see at an early age, check them out, try them out, and ask non-stop questions. At such times, their questions should be answered in a clear, understandable, simple way, without melting.

In order to provide moral education (aesthetic and sexual), first of all, parents need to set an example for their children in the field of morality and etiquette, to teach them etiquette regularly. Because etiquette is one of the main means of conveying the blessings of the Hereafter. This idea is equally confirmed in all religions. Both the Qur'an and the hadiths of

the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) pay special attention to the issue of morality. The purpose of willpower training is to develop your child into a strong-willed person. In doing so, the child is taught to fight against his own concupiscence, to control his personal desires and needs or, if necessary, to give them up, not to put his own interests above the interests of others and society. In practice, the upbringing of the will, which is carried out in the period of the stubbornness of the child (from four to sixteen years), requires a little rigid, endurance, but at the same time let him feel love, kindness, sincerity. Speech education also plays an important role in a child's development. Usually, boys and girls start talking at the age of one and a half to two years. They need to be taught from an early age the correct pronunciation of words, eloquence, the etiquette of addressing adults, the evil of insulting and using obscene words. Since imitation of adults is strong in children, it is necessary to refrain from immorality, insulting words, swearing, rudeness, and slander in front of them. One must be very careful in raising one's child. Because, as we said above, they imitate adults very quickly. First and foremost, we need to tell the kids the truth. Now we need to immediately warn that such words are not good, without being indifferent to the vulgar words that come out of our child's mouth when the language comes out. Otherwise, one day those words may have a negative effect on our child's upbringing. In order to bring up a child to work, he is advised to make a living by an honest profession, and from childhood, he is instructed in various small tasks in order to awaken a love for work. Different professions are taught, and if one is unable to do so, it is given to a teacher. In which family, in which neighborhood the upbringing is well organized, that family, that neighborhood will prosper. The children will grow up, a prosperous family will be formed.

The well-being of the family is the foundation of the well-being of the nation. Life, progress, is constantly rising, reaching new heights.
