

THE INFLUENCE OF WORKING PARENTS' PARENTING PATTERNS ON SELF-DISCLOSURE ON STUDENTS

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine the parenting styles of parents who work on self-disclosure in students. The approach used in this research is a quantitative approach. Data was collected through a questionnaire in the form of google form. A total of 143 students became respondents in this study. The measuring instruments used are the Scale of Parenting Style made by Abdul Gafoor and Abidha Kurukan to measure parenting styles and the Revised Self-disclosure Scale made by Wheelless and Grotz to measure self-disclosure. The result of this study is that there is no influence of working parents' parenting styles on student self-disclosure.
